1. Co-Owner A is the primary care giver and agrees to cover all expenses required for this care. These include but are not limited to veterinary bills, feeding costs and grooming expenses.
 2. Co-Owner A agrees to have this puppy's hips radiographed at 2 years of age for OFA evaluation and to have a CERF examination performed. If hips or eyes are deemed unsuitable for breeding it may be altered by Co-Owner A. Co-Owner B has the right to finish the dogs Championship before the dog is altered.
 3. Co-Owner A agrees to have this puppy's eyes re-cleared by a board certified veterinary ophthalmologist at 1 year of age and again at 2 years of age. If heritable eye disease is found the dog must be altered by Co-Owner A.

4. If for any reason Co-Owner A is unable to keep the dog then Co-Owner B has the first option to retake possession of the dog for no more than half of the original purchase price.
5. Co-Owners must agree on the stud dog or brood bitch for ALL litters.
6. Co-Owner A is to receive 1 puppy back from a litter out of this brood bitch or dog or the price thereof.
7. Co-Owner B is to receive second pick puppy. If Co-Owner A is not keeping first pick puppy then Co-Owner B has the right to take this puppy instead of second pick. If only one puppy is born in the first litter it belongs to Co-Owner A and Co-Owner B will wait for the next litter. If only one pup is born again Co-Owner B has the first right to that one puppy.
8. Breeder's kennel name is to appear on the puppy's AKC registration papers.
9. Co-Owner A agrees to show and make all attempts to finish this dogs AKC Championship. If a reasonable effort is not made then Co-Owner B may take possession of the dog for this purpose. Co-Owner B would then cover these show expenses.
10. If the dog is found to be sterile or turns out not to be of breeding quality then Co-Owner A may keep the dog with nothing owed to Co-Owner B. The dog also may be sold and the purchase price will be divided equally between Co-Owners. Both Co-Owners must agree dog is not of breeding quality.
